**Anthony Joseph** is a Trinidad-born, London-based author, poet and musician. He's published four poetry collections and three novels, and released seven critically acclaimed albums, including *People of the Sun* (2018).

Andrew John is a London-based electric bassist/composer, incorporating a heavy grooved style coupled with a melodic musical outlook which incorporates funk and jazz-inspired improvisations.

**Denys Baptiste** is a British jazz musician from London, where he was born to St Lucian parents. A graduate of Tomorrow's Warriors, Baptiste plays tenor and soprano saxophone in addition to composing.

**Thibaut Remy** is a French/Algerian guitarist with a strong interest in Afro-Latin music. He has toured with many bands such as Laxula, Los Chinches, Yaaba Funk, Afrik Bawantu, the Urban Nomads, and his band Awalé, for whom he arranges and composes.

A native of Washington DC, London-based drummer **Rod Youngs** developed an interest and appreciation for music at an early age. His approach to music is intuitive, emotional and all-embracing but soundly rooted in the jazz tradition.
