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RAYMOND CORMIER has been First Gent Emeritus at Longwood University, Virginia, since 2010, having previously served as a Visiting Professor of French from 1997, where he taught courses in French language and literature as well as English, ESL and World literature. He was born in Connecticut, USA, in 1938, and earned degrees from the U. of Bridgeport (A.B., 1960; hon. D.Litt, 1980) and Stanford (A.M.). In 1967 Harvard University awarded him the Ph.D. in Romance and Celtic languages and literatures. He also studied at the University of Edinburgh, Dublin, Ireland (Inst. for Advanced Studies); and (to focus on glossed Virgil manuscripts) at numerous European research libraries, including those in Leiden, Bern, Paris, Lille, London, Brussels, New York, Florence, the Vatican, Madrid, Barcelona, and Montpellier. He has been working principally on the Old French adaptation of Virgil's *Aeneid* since 1969, resulting in two major monographs published in 1973 and 2011.

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
